Inference Problems

- No inferences
 - ■"Greasers"
 - ■"Socs"
 - "Fighting"
 - "It is good"

Inference Problems

- Obvious (ob) inferences
 - "Greasers are fair"
 - "They stay together"
 - "Fighting is one-on-one"
 - Don't want to get caught"

Inference Problems

- Inferences not about Greaser culture
 - "Socs hate greasers"
 - "Two-bit likes fighting "
 - Dally is going to pay for the tires"

Problems

No specific details or quotes from the passage

Problems Let's look at some examples

Greasers

- "Greasers usually stick together"
- They stick together and don't get caught"

Not an inference

Fight using their fists

- Skin fighting ain't rough
- "There's nothing wrong with throwing a few punches"

Obvious inference

Dallas likes to fight

- What's wrong with this?
 - It doesn't focus on Greaser culture; it focuses on only one of the characters.

They don't care about their future

- There is nothing wrong with throwing a few punches."
- *"Slashed tires ain't no joke."

Good inference

Inference or Detail?

- They are poor" (inference)
- "Troublemakers" (obvious)
- "They stick together" (detail)
- "Greasers live in a tough neighborhood." (inference)

To get advanced...

 Explain how the detail you chose proves your inference.

They don't care about their future.

- There is nothing wrong with throwing a few punches.
 - Usually people that do bad things don't think of getting a record and how it will affect their future.

Good or Bad Explanation for "They want to be identified as a Greaser."

- Since they all wear the same clothes, it is easy to identify them as Greasers." (OK except for the Greaser reference)
- Usually people in groups have the same taste in clothes."(good)

Good or Bad Explanation for "Greasers live in a tough neighborhood."

- The Socs commit crimes like jumping Greasers." (bad because it has stuff from the book)
- *"If there is a lot of crime and fights in your neighborhood, it must be tough to live there."

 (good)
